How everything started: Hanover

• 1831 Foundation of "Higher Trade School" with 11 staff members and 103 students by the King of Hanover. Today Leibniz University

 Wilhelm Jordan, the first geodesist who exclusively taught surveying subjects, was appointed as professor.



1882 - 1899

• 2031 200 years of Leibniz University of Hannover and 150 years of Geodesy!






How everything started: Societies of Photogrammetry

• 1907 Foundation of the "Austrian Society for Photogrammetry" by Prof. Eduard Dolezal

 1908 In honour of the late French pioneer Aimé Laussedat (1907 †) a photogrammetric association was established as section of the French Society for Photography.





How everything started: Societies of Photogrammetry

1909 "Ferienkurs für Stereophotogrammetrie" in Jena organized by *Carl Pulfrich* (Today Photogrammetric Week, since 1973 held in Stuttgart)

How everything started: Societies of Photogrammetry

• 1909 The decisive meeting to establish also a German society took place in a good wine bar at the marketplace of Jena...

And now? The International Society of Photogrammetry!

• 4.7.1910 Dolezal founds the *Internationale Gesellschaft für Photogrammetrie*, the German and Austrian Societies become members.

The ISP(RS) Achieves also date back to this era!



- 1913 1. Congress der Internationalen Gesellschaft für Photogrammetrie held in Vienna!
- 1926 2. Congress conducted at TU Berlin





Back to Hanover

• Around 1930 photogrammetry found acknowledgment as an independent scientific discipline.

- 1927 Paul Gast was appointed to Director of Geodetic Institute Hanover
 - 1927: Establishment of photogrammetric and cartographic laboratories
 - 1930: Gast published one of the first textbooks about Photogrammetry: "Vorlesungen über Photogrammetrie"

• Another key person in this era was Richard Finsterwalder







After II. World War: A new Start in 1949

- Reestablishment of *Deutsche Gesellschaft für Photogrammetrie e.V. (DGP)* for FRG in Munich, President R. Finsterwalder
 - GDR: 1960 foundation of Gesellschaft für Photogrammetrie in der DDR
- In Hanover two separate institutes were created:
 - The Geodetic Institute with Professor Walter Großmann as director

and

 The Institut für Photogrammetrie und Ingenieurvermessungen (IPI, Institute for Photogrammetry and Engineering Surveys) with Professor Gerhard Lehmann



- Both served as DGP presidents
 - Gottfried Konecny: 1972 76
 - Fritz Ackermann: 1976 80 (Vice-President Gottfried Konecny)
- Initiate and foster international cooperation, networking, diplomacy...
 - Early travels to China in the late 70s, early 80s
 - High national and international reputation
- First-class researchers, innovators and managers
 - Widening scope of DFP to DGPF (Fernerkundung = Remote Sensing) in 1976

• All of those efforts paved the way for...





Gottfried Konecny's ongoing commitment to the ISPRS

- ISPRS working group chairman
 - 1972-1976: WG III/1, "Geometry of Remote Sensing Systems"
 - 1992-2000: IV/2 & IV/4 "Mapping from Space"
- ISPRS council member
 - 1976-1980: Congress Director
 - 1980-1984: Secretary General
 - 1984-1988: President
 - 1988-1992: 1st Vice President
- Later years: ISPRS Ad-hoc Committee "Knowledge Transfer"
- Countless further activities...
- Honorary member of ISPRS since 1992 (Ackermann since 1996)








Hot topics at the turn of the millennium: Sensors

• Photogrammetry: new sensors and platforms











Remote Sensing: SAR and SAR Interferometry!
